Rare Corvettes Reunited at NCRS Event on November 10th... in Napoleon, Ohio as ProTeam Corvette hosted almost 200 Corvette faithful at a NCRS Corvette seminar featuring some of today's foremost Corvette

researchers and a panel including the GM engineers who crafted the Corvette's image and its sports car tradition. The participants were over-shadowed by the real stars of the day-long event by three 1953-55 Corvettes fashioned by Chevrolet Engineering (Experimental Shop and Garage) for NASCAR stock car activity (racing) and a 1963 "Cinderella story".

The three 1953-55 Corvettes on display have left an indelible mark of the Corvette's legacy, NASCAR and Sebring. Among the three was #1194 that went onto win in 1956 at Sebring with John Fitch and Walt Hansgen co-driving in this 12-hour race. Campbell-Ewald, Chevrolet's advertising agency, celebrated the Corvette's first international class victory with "The Real McCoy" advertisement which millions have seen.

Dick Lang's storied 1963 Z06 Tanker Race Car was unveiled publically for the first time since its yearlong restoration. This is one of the early "batched built" 1963 Z06 Corvettes that battled Shelby's Cobras back in 1963 and 1964. This car's driver, Dick Lang, was one of the best Corvette drivers in the late 50's and early 60's. In 1963 Lang raced at Daytona International in two events; that weekend kicked off a winning streak including many notable podium appearances. In 1964, Lang's Corvette stood alone alongside 4 Cobras in the top 5. It was this race when the fastest and most desirable cars in the world surrounded the Corvette and its story as America's muscle car was written. Dick Lang's Z06 Tanker is as testament to the driver and the celebrated legacy of Chevrolet. The restoration was performed by the world famous Naber Brothers of Houston, Texas.

John Hinckley, a retired engineer, put on a phenomenal power point slide show presentation about the St. Louis mid year assembly process that kept the audience in their seats even if they had to use the restroom.

David Burroughs, founder of Bloomington Gold, introduced two unique new collector car services. The first service, named <u>Prove It</u>, is a team of research experts that analyze the claims or rumors about an individual vehicle. <u>Prove It</u> reviews an owner's evidence and provides authentication whether the claim is true, highly probable, probable, possible, inconclusive, or false. The second new service presented is an intense two-day training clinic named <u>Zero to Sixty in Two Days</u>. It is designed to help people new to Corvette community accelerate their knowledge from 0% to 60% within two days and learn how to "read" a Corvette within ten minutes. The objective is to give attendees enough knowledge to make them self-reliant to do their own prepurchase inspections and avoid paying too much or buying a Corvette they wished they hadn't.


