The 1983 Corvette was introduced in March 1983 but was designated/titled as a 1984 which makes for interesting chatter... The 1993 was Chevrolet's 40th anniversary model. The 2003 was Chevrolet's 50th anniversary model... and it is with much anticipation as to what The General has in mind for 2013. I'm sure it will not be boring as this will mark the 60th Anniversary of the Corvette. Every Corvette collection should consider the


