Ess's name was drawn at the conclusion of the St. Bernard Summer Social on July 8. Ess is a true Corvette enthusiast, owning over 40 Corvettes in his lifetime. After a tour of the church and photos, Ess drove through the streets of Rockport before the trip back to New York.

After 46 years, this classic Corvette returns home. This particular Corvette was manufactured in May of 1966 and delivered new to RM Burritt in Oswego, NY; only 100 miles from the home of the raffle winner.
