**PROTEAM ENTERS NINE CORVETTES
FOR VETTEFEST AWARDS**

- A 1967 silver 427 hp coupe, The “Last” Corvette Sting Ray
- A 1969 blue L-88 convertible
- A 1969 burgundy L-88 convertible
